RULES AND COURT ETIQUETTE

Fair Use of the Courts

- 1 Duration of Play - If there are members waiting to play and all courts are occupied, then those who were first on court should play no more than the set that is in progress, or play for 30 minutes, whichever is the shorter.
- 2 Involve waiting players - Players engaged in a singles game are encouraged to invite players waiting to form a four for doubles, if all courts are in use.
- 3 Club Matches, Events and Coaching - Any club matches, events and planned coaching will whenever possible be posted on the website at least seven days before the date of play or otherwise as soon as possible by e-mail. These activities will take priority over social matches. Court 4 is marked out as a practice court and coaching will take priority over social tennis on this court. Members and Guests using this court must quickly yield to coaches then complete their game on another court as soon as one is available.
- 4 Precedence for Junior Members (17 or less at 1st Jan) - Junior members will have precedence on the courts between 4.00 and 6.30pm MONDAY to FRIDAY. At other times they must offer to yield to adult members who are waiting.

Social Tennis Sessions

- 5 Club Nights - Club balls will be available.. A Committee member will be present during the winter months to manage the lighting.
 - a. All adult members (18 or more) are welcome to attend on Monday or Wednesday evenings from 6.30 until 10.00pm.
 - b. All junior members together who know the rules and can score, serve and rally with yellow ball, on Monday evenings from 5.30 until 6.30pm

Guests

- 6 There is a charge of £2 payable in respect of a non-member playing as a guest of a member. Please leave the cash in the box provided for this purpose at the courts. An **adult** member may bring **up to 3 guests [Junior members 1 playing guest if supervised by an adult]** on any one day and each guest should not exceed **4** visits per year.

Dress

- 7 Dress for all members should be tennis wear/ sports wear. IT IS COMPULSORY FOR NON-MARKING SHOES SUITABLE FOR TENNIS TO BE WORN by everyone on court. "Astro trainers" damage the surface and are NOT permitted. Everybody within the boundary fence must wear their tops at all times.

Security

- 8 Members must not disclose padlock combinations to anyone. Those who should know it will have been given the information in writing. Refer all enquiries to the Secretary.
- 9 IT IS VITAL TO ENSURE THAT THE COURTS AND CLUBHOUSE ARE LOCKED when you have finished playing, if they are not in use by others. Those adult members requiring the access code must apply to the secretary in writing.

Care of the Courts and Clubhouse

- 10 Please pay due attention to the condition of the court surfaces, nets, and clubhouse. Should you find any instances of undue wear and tear or damage, please notify a Committee member.
- 11 Every effort should be made to keep the surface of the courts clean and unmarked.
- 12 In winter months and after wet weather, members are requested to change into their tennis shoes in the clubhouse's changing room to avoid bringing mud from outside into the courts.
- 13 Non-marking shoes suitable for tennis should be worn at all times and please ensure that these are clean. "Astro trainers" damage the surface and are NOT permitted.
- 14 Drinks cans, glass bottles and chewing gum are not permitted within the boundary fence.
